

## WAAE TEACHING MATERIALS CONTEST

The purpose of this contest is to promote creative teaching methods of instruction and/or tools used in the classroom or for the local chapter. One Award Winner will be chosen per division, with an Overall Best Award for the top entry of all divisions. All Award Winners will receive monetary compensation. All entries may be student or teacher produced. You may enter as many divisions as you wish. Please limit yourself one entry per division.

The WAAE TEACHING AIDS CONTEST is supported by CENEX COOPERATIVES and WAAE.

### DIVISION CATEGORIES:

- A. ANIMAL SCIENCE: A unit or method of instruction that assists in the teaching of animal science.
- B. PLANT SCIENCE: A unit or method of instruction that assists in the teaching of horticulture, crop and plant science.
- C. NATURAL RESOURCES: A unit or method of instruction that assists in the teaching of natural resources.
- D. VISUAL AIDS: Power points, videos, transparencies, etc. that present a specific teaching idea for the classroom.
- E. AG. MECHANICS/WOODWORKING: Ideas or methods used in the instruction of mechanics or shop activities.
- F. COMPUTER PROGRAMS: May be original or use of a commercial program. It must include purpose and example print-out.
- G. PROMOTE YOUR PROGRAM: Methods used in promotion of your agricultural education program or FFA Chapter.
- H. COMMUNITY SERVICE: Activities or ideas used to create bonds with the community.
- I. CHAPTER DEVELOPMENT: Ideas or activities used to develop your FFA Chapter Activities.
- J. FOOD SCIENCE: A unit or method of instruction that assists in the teaching of food science.
- K MISCELLANEOUS: All items that do not meet a previous division.

**\*\*HUMOROUS\*\*** Noteworthy stories, jokes, videos, etc., that relate to agriculture programs in some way. (This is not a judged area.)

NOTE! Displays or demonstrations can be used in any division where applicable.

### GENERAL RULES

1. Entry for this contest will be Monday during registration by filling out the attached form.
2. Set up will be on Tuesday from 7 a.m. to NOON. ABSOLUTELY no entries taken past Tuesday noon of summer conference! Judging takes place Tuesday afternoon.
3. Materials will be judged on instructional value, quality, and originality.
4. An instructor may enter as many divisions as desired.
5. All exhibitors are expected to bring special equipment needed to make their presentations.
6. Award stickers or ribbons will be placed on the top three entries in each division. An instructor may win only one division in each year's contest.
7. An overall winner for the best exhibit will be given based on the decision of the judges.
8. Entrant may not enter a previous winning entry.
9. Award recognition will be announced. Cash awards will be presented for winners in each division.
10. Ideas or materials may only be entered in one contest area.

WAAE will contribute \$500.00 for additional awards.
