WAAE Committee Responsibilities:

- Track pool of mentors with three years experience

- Review applications against mentor criteria
- Review future needs for an area mentor
- Conduct ongoing reviews of the program

DPI Representative Responsibilities:

- Provide mentee list
- Partner with the WAAE committee to continuously review the program
